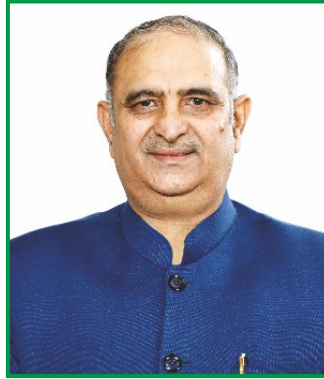

1. ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The Extension Education Institute (EEI), Nilokheri was established in 1952 as a Gramsevak–Training Centre (GTC) and later on in 1959 it was re-designated as Extension Education Institute. The Department of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers welfare, Govt. of India has established different EEIs for four regions in the country: EEI (Northern Region) at Nilokheri, Haryana (1959), EEI (Southern Region) at Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh (1962), EEI (Western Region) at Anand, Gujarat (1962), and EEI (North Eastern Region) at Jorhat, Assam (1987). The Extension Education Institute, Nilokheri was established in 1959 as the first training institute of its kind in the country during the second five-year plan. The institute's main mandate is to provide in-service training to middle-level extension functionaries. It is one of the pioneer and premier extension training institutes of the country which carries the responsibility of organizing the training for the various departments including Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry & Dairy, Forestry, Fisheries, Sericulture, Watershed Management, Rural Development and Master Trainers of SAMETIs of the northern states and Union Territories of India viz., Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Uttrakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Ladakh, Chandigarh. In the year 1991, its administrative control was handed over to Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar and since then it is functioning under the administrative control of CCS HAU, Hisar on the basis of a Memorandum of Understanding between Department of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India New Delhi and CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar.

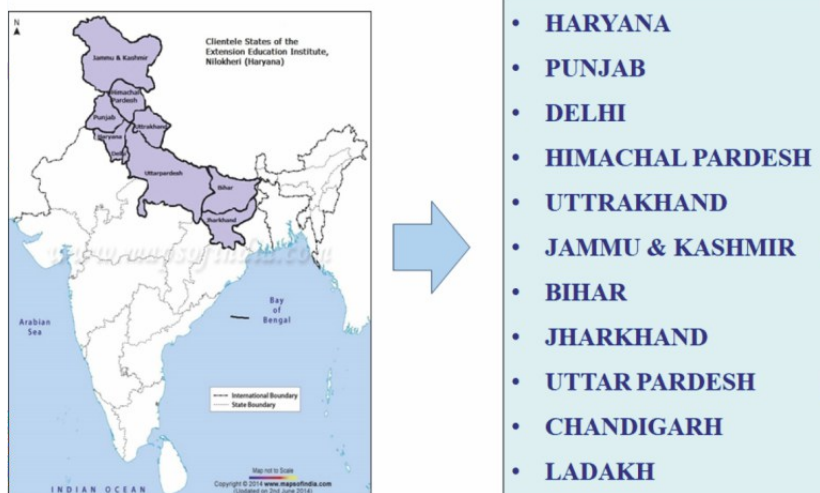


Fig. 1.1 : Clientele States/UTs

1.1 History Related To Nilokheri Town:

Town Nilokheri has a special place in the history of country and was most popular to its special experiment, entitled as "Nilokheri experiment" (the programme which was originally started to rehabilitate 7000 displaced persons from Pakistan after partition and later on integrated with the 100 surrounding villages, that came to be a rural cum urban township). The central figure of this project was Shri. Surendra Kumar Dey, (Sept. 13, 1906 – May 24, 1989) who was India's first Union Cabinet minister for Cooperation and Panchyati Raj (Plate 1). Mr. Dey is remembered as the man who pioneered and steered community development in independent India. He firmly believed that democracy cannot be practiced by government servants and stressed that the fruits of democracy ought to reach every village. In 1949, Mr. Dey designed the concept of an agro-industrial township for rural development.

The thrust of this model was to focus on a combination of agriculture and industrial development. Schools, agricultural farm, polytechnic training centre, dairy, poultry farm, piggery farm, horticultural garden, printing press for currency, garment factory, engineering workshop, soap factory, etc. were established at Nilokheri and people were trained in the vocational training centre as per their choices to maintain these cooperatives enterprises. Mr. Dey considered this model to be welfare state in action. Impressed with the model, Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru termed Nilokheri to be the “Mecca of Development” and called for the creation of many more Nilokheri across the country. Unfortunately, over the years, Nilokheri has been lost to obscurity.

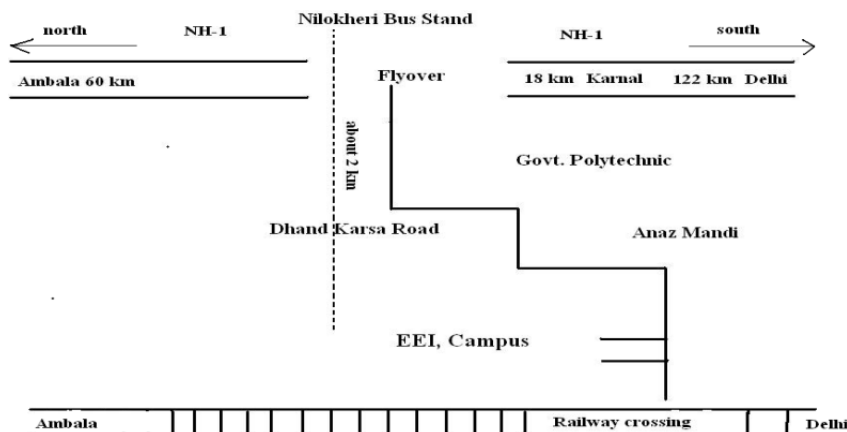


Fig. 1.2 : Map showing different routes to EEI, Nilokheri

The Extension Education Institute (EEI), Nilokheri is located in between of Karnal and Kurukshetra (Pipli) districts of Haryana (Fig. 1.2). The distance from Nilokheri to Karnal, Pipli, ISBT Chandigarh and ISBT Delhi is 18, 27, 125 and 144 km, respectively. Nilokheri Railway Station is merely 750 m away from EEI campus.

1.2 Aims and Objectives

The institute caters to the training needs of middle level extension functionaries of State Agricultural Universities, Department of Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, Forestry, Soil Conservation, Fisheries, Agricultural Engineering, Women & Child Development and Rural Development *etc.* It has responsibility of organizing in-service courses for middle level extension personnel engaged directly or indirectly in broad based agricultural extension system. EEI also coordinates with esteemed organizations like MANAGE, NIPHM, IIWBR, NDRI, HIRD, SAMETIs *etc.*, to provide training to extension functionaries on recent advancements in agriculture and allied sectors. The training at EEI Nilokheri are planned to achieve the the following objectives:

- To provide in-service training to staff of the State Training Institutes/Staff of Line Departments/State Agril. Universities in Extension Teaching Methods and Communication Media.
- To organize Workshops on Communication and Extension Teaching Methods/Training Methodology for Master Trainers/ Sub Divisional Agricultural Officers/Subject Matter Specialists working under broad based Agricultural Extension.
- To conduct Workshops in specialized fields like Monitoring and Evaluation, Supervision & Extension Management for Middle Level Extension personnel working under Broad based Agricultural Extension.
- To undertake programme of publication and production of basic teaching/ training material as relevant to extension personnel.
- To have continuous programme of field studies on Extension Education and Allied subjects.

1.3 Activities of Institute

The Institute organizes the following type of training courses for middle level extension and field functionary officers of the clientele states and UTs:

On-campus training: The training programmes which are conducted at EEI Nilokheri campus.

Off-campus training: The programmes which are conducted at SAMETIs of all clientele states. Faculty from EEI Nilokheri with the involvement of local resource persons organized these kind of trainings.

Off-campus training(s) as per proposal received from different SAUs: The another off-campus training programs which are conducted at Directorate of Extension Education of different state agricultural universities from clientele states after receiving the proposal from them.

Collaborative online training(s) at campus: It includes online training program with MANAGE, NIPHM and any other institute as suggested by management committee kind of online training. It also includes collaborative training programs with institutes like HIRD, NDRI, IIWBR *etc.* at EEI campus.

1.4 Administration of the Institute

Since its inception, the institute has been working under Department of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers welfare, Govt. of India New Delhi. The administrative control and overall management of the institute transferred to CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar w.e.f. 01.02.1991. Now the Institute is working under the guidance of the Management Committee constituted by the Govt. of India where Vice-Chancellor, CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar is the chairman and regional director EEI, Nilokheri is the Member secretary. The main function of this committee is to provide guidance and to take any policy decisions related to the institute. The present members of this committee are as under:

1.5 Training Planning Process Through Academic Committee

1.6 Facilities Provided to Participants/Trainees

- Free boarding and lodging
- To and fro journey fare as per entitlement
- Supporting literature/reading material

Administrative block: It is an old and spacious building in round shape, catering to both administrative and educational needs, which comprises Regional Director's office, faculty and ministerial staff chambers/offices, computer lab and library, it is functional with 24 hours broad band service facility.

Participants hostel: A well-furnished participants' Hostel (having 24 rooms) equipped with all the latest facilities such as Wi-Fi, AC, LCD TV, electric geyser, room heater, water dispenser and water cooler etc. It is used to provide lodging and boarding facilities to the participants. It also serves as a guest house for various dignitaries visiting the institute for official purposes.

Lounge: Lounge facility is also available in the participants' hostel with LCD and magazine facilities for dignitaries/trainees. It is also utilized for meeting and greeting.

Seminar hall: It is used to impart training to the participants as well as meeting. It is equipped with following facilities:

- Interactive Panel
- Smart Board
- Internet Facility
- Air Conditioners

Syndicate room: It is used to complete the assignments and small meeting of the institute.

Library: It provides the information support to its staff (teaching and non-teaching) and trainees. It is endowed with good collection of books on agricultural extension and allied subjects. The library has a large print collection of about 3,900 books and other reading materials. In addition, it is also enriched with various farm magazines and journals. Newspapers subscription by the library.

Computer lab: Computers with internet connectivity for completion of the assignment during the training programme.

CCTV cameras: Campus is under 24x7 CCTV cameras surveillance for campus safety and monitoring.

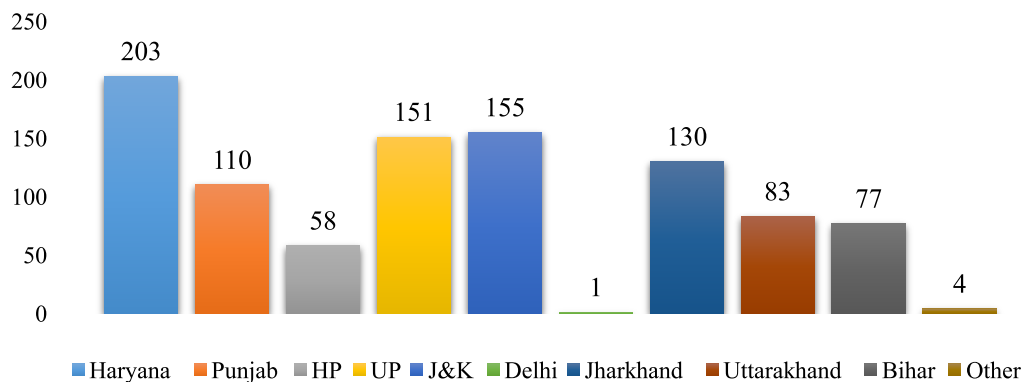


Fig. 2.1 : State-wise distribution of participants in training (2023-24)

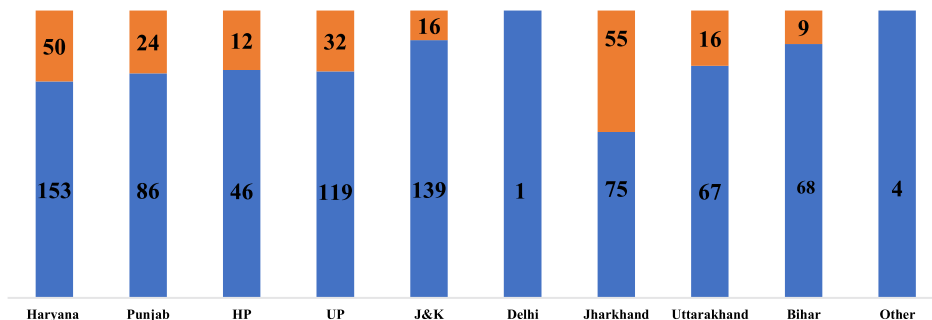


Fig. 2.2 : Participation in Training (2023-24)

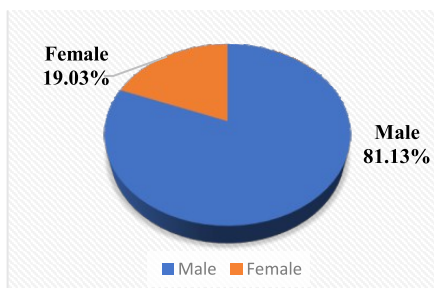


Fig. 2.3 : Gender distribution of participation during 2023-24

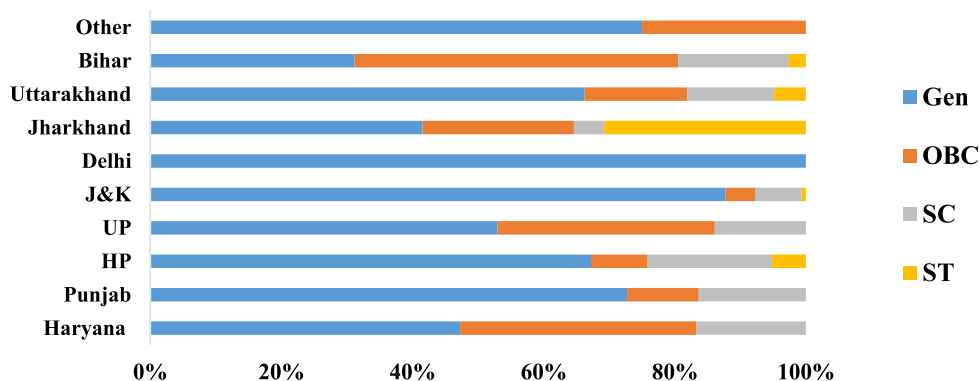


Fig. 2.4 : Gender-wise details of the participants (2023-24)

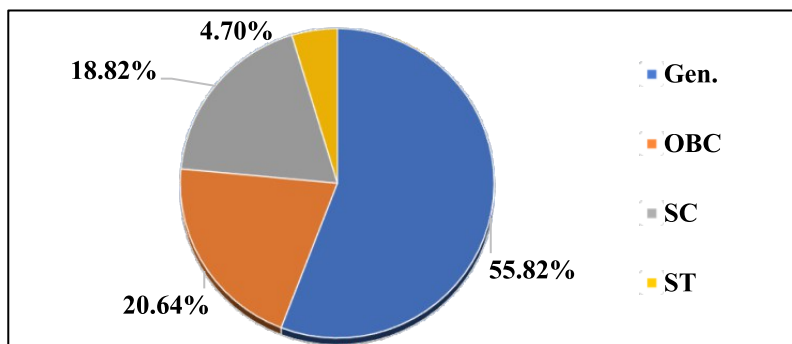


Fig. 2.5 : Social category wise distribution of participants during 2022-23

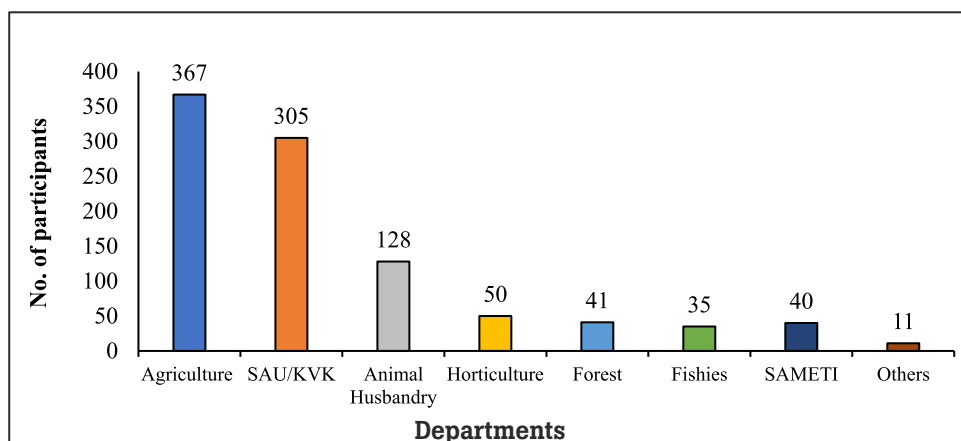


Fig. 2.6 : Department wise distribution of participants during 2023-24

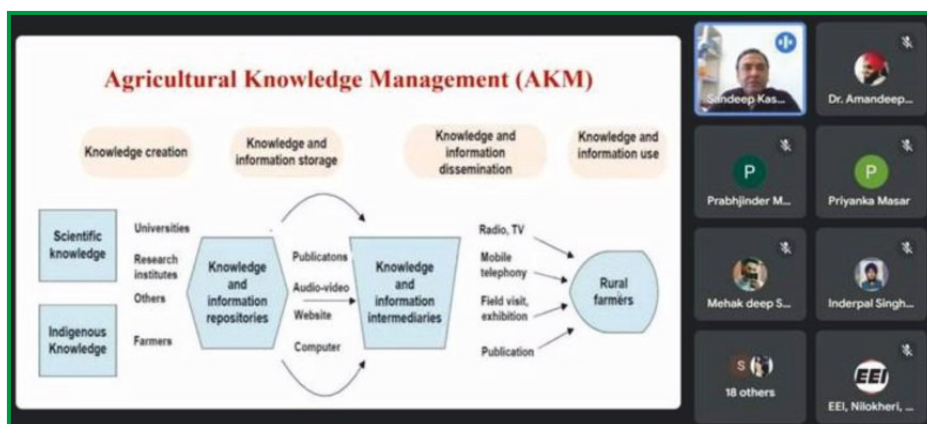
